Join us as we embark on this journey of knowledge and camaraderie. We are eager to share this extraordinary experience with you and believe that your contributions will significantly enrich our discussions.

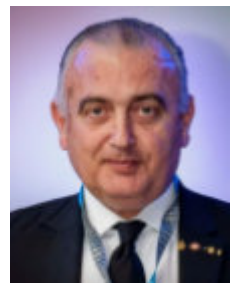

We warmly invite all interested parties to join us in Niš, from September 10 to 13, 2026.

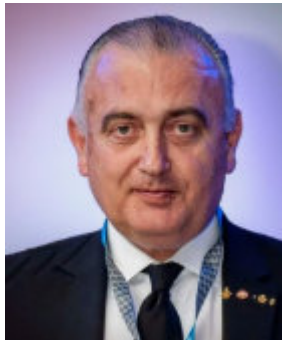

Certificate of Attendance

A certificate of attendance will be issued to delegates. An application will be made to the UEMS EACCME® for CME accreditation of this event and to the Health Council of the Republic of Serbia.

Registration Cancellation Terms

Requests for registration cancellation must be submitted in writing to the Secretariat office@snss.org.rs.

For cancellations received more than 121 days before event, we charge a cancellation fee of 0.00% of the reservation value.

For cancellations received 120–46 days before event, we charge a cancellation fee of 50.00% of the reservation value.

For cancellations received 45–1 days before event, we charge a cancellation fee of 100.00% of the reservation value.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The deadline for abstract submission is June 15, 2026.

Please read the guidelines and instructions carefully before submitting your abstract.

All abstracts will be reviewed. Accepted abstracts will be published in the Abstract Book. According to the decision of the Scientific Committee, **10 best abstracts** will be awarded with free registration and accommodation. **The awardees will be announced on August 15th, 2026.**

Submission Guidelines

- | Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- | Titles should contain no more than 200 characters.
- | Abstract text should contain no more than 500 words.
- | Use standard abbreviations. Place a special or unusual abbreviation in parenthesis after the full word when it appears for the first time.
- | Abstracts must be written in comprehensible English and must conform to the guidelines or they will not be accepted. It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract.
- | Any tables, graphs or diagrams should be upload together with the abstract.
- | The organizers of this event take no responsibility for any published abstracts submitted. Any issues or errors arising from the abstracts are solely the responsibility of the authors.
- | Changes to abstract can only be accepted until the deadline
- | By submitting his / her / their work, the Author(s) consent to the publication of the abstract and transfer and assign to the Congress organizers the rights to edit, publish, reproduce, distribute copies and to prepare derivative works such as press releases. Author(s) represent and warrants that he / she / they is / are sole author(s) of the work, that all authors have participated in and agree with the content and conclusions of the work, and that the work is original and does not infringe upon any copyright, proprietary or personal right of any third party. If the work is not original, author(s) should reference original source and ensure all relevant permission and / or authorization to re-use have been obtained.



Notification of Acceptance

- Upon submission, you will receive an acknowledgement email notifying that your abstract has been received.
- Once the Abstract Submission closes, all abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to select the abstracts relevant to the sessions and decide on the final form of presentation.
- Notification of acceptance/rejection will be e-mailed to you no later than August 15th, 2026.
- If the abstract is accepted, applicant **MUST** register and pay registration fee.
- All successfully accepted abstract submitters must present their abstract in the form of Oral Presentation during the Congress.
- The corresponding author will receive any correspondence concerning the abstract.

Awards

The Best Oral presentation will be awarded with SeENS and SNSS Awards. The papers submitted for the awards will be presented by their authors and assessed by a jury of national and international experts. **Eligible for competing are neurosurgeons below the age of 40.**

How to arrive to the Radisson Hotel Park, Niš	
 From Niš Constantine the Great Airport (INI)	<p>By car/taxi: Constantine the Great Airport is located just 4.5 kilometers away from the hotel. Hop on Bulevar Nikole Tesle straight to the city center; the journey should take between 15 and 18 minutes depending on traffic.</p> <p>By bus: From the airport, hop on the 348 bus to the city center and get off at the Trg kralja Milana stop before walking 300 meters to the hotel. Alternatively, take bus 34A, get down at Ured bus stop and walk 700 meters to the hotel. The journey should take around 25 to 30 minutes depending on traffic.</p>
 From Niš Train Station	<p>By car/taxi: Niš Train Station is just 2 kilometers away from our hotel. The ride should take around eight minutes depending on traffic.</p> <p>By bus: At the train station, hop on bus number 5 or 6 and get off at the Trg kralja Milana stop. The journey should take around 11 minutes.</p>
 From Niš Bus Station	<p>By car/taxi: The hotel is a 12-minute car ride from Niš Bus Station.</p> <p>By foot: Located 1 kilometer away from the hotel, the walk from Niš Bus Station is around 15 minutes long.</p>
