Registration will only be valid upon receipt of the full payment by the registration department according to the deadline indicated. An email confirming registration will only be sent after receipt of the required fees.

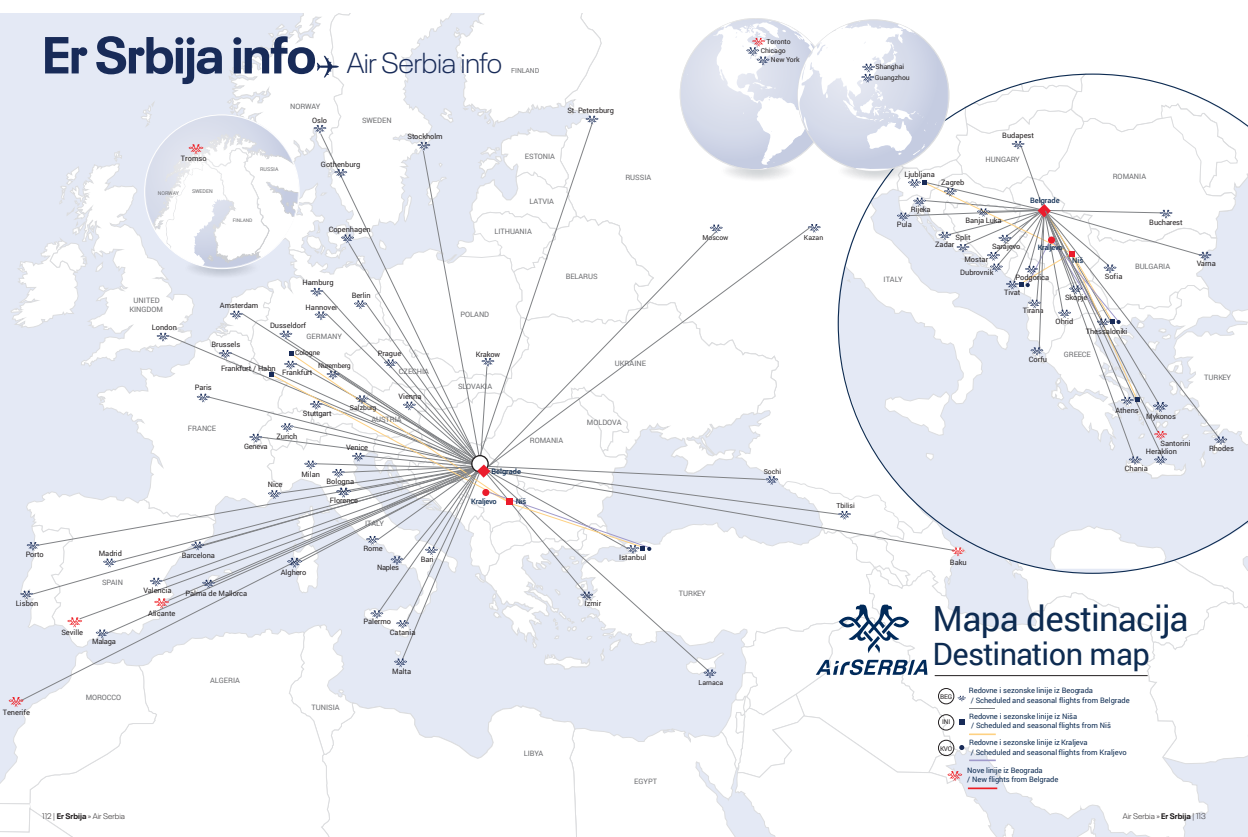

Flights to Nis

There are currently 3 airlines that offer flights from the airport.

The national flag carrier of Serbia “Air Serbia” offers 5 direct flights from Nis during Winter season (Frankfurt-Hahn, Cologne, Istanbul, Ljubljana and Belgrade) and 2 more direct flights during Summer season (Athens and Tivat). The Hungarian, low-budget airline “Wizz Air” offers 5 direct flights to European destinations (Malmo, Dortmund, Basel, Memmingen and Vienna), while Irish airline “Ryanair” offers 4 (Corfu – summer season, Malta, Stockholm and Vienna).

How to get to Niš

By car

The city of Niš has a very good road connection, since it is located at the crossroads of the most important Balkan and European traffic routes.

In Niš, the main route, which leads from the north, from the direction of Hungary and Belgrade (E-75), forks towards the south – towards Thessaloniki and Athens, and the direction towards the east (E-80) – towards Sofia, Istanbul and further towards The Middle East. There are also local roads to the northeast towards – Zaječar, Kladovo and Timisoara (Romania) and in the southwest direction, towards – the Adriatic Sea.

The “Constantine the Great” International Airport is the second largest airport in Serbia, after the Belgrade “Nikola Tesla” airport. Thanks to numerous flights of the national airline Air Serbia, as well as low coast airlines, Niš has excellent connections with major cities in Europe: Frankfurt, Dortmund, Meningen, Vienna, Basel, Malmo... During the summer there are seasonal flights connecting Niš with Tivat/Montenegro/, Malta, Corfu...

- | Use standard abbreviations. Place a special or unusual abbreviation in parenthesis after the full word when it appears for the first time.
- | Abstracts must be written in comprehensible English and must conform to the guidelines or they will not be accepted. It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract.
- | Any tables, graphs or diagrams should be upload together with the abstract.
- | The organizers of this event take no responsibility for any published abstracts submitted. Any issues or errors arising from the abstracts are solely the responsibility of the authors.
- | Changes to abstract can only be accepted until the deadline
- | By submitting his / her / their work, the Author(s) consent to the publication of the abstract and transfer and assign to the Congress organizers the rights to edit, publish, reproduce, distribute copies and to prepare derivative works such as press releases. Notification of acceptance/rejection will be e-mailed to you no later than August 15th, 2026.

If the abstract is accepted, applicant **MUST** register and pay registration fee.

All successfully accepted abstract submitters must present their abstract in the form of Oral Presentation during the Congress.

The corresponding author will receive any correspondence concerning the abstract.

The Best Oral presentation will be awarded with SeENS and SNSS Awards. The papers submitted for the awards will be presented by their authors and assessed by a jury of national and international experts. **Eligible for competing are neurosurgeons below the age of 40.**
